One where addicts are provided with FDA-approved synthetic opiates under medical supervision19%

 Not sure32%

2. Here are two arguments about the use of synthetic drugs like suboxone or methadone to treat heroin addiction. Which do you agree with more?

Synthetic drugs are more dangerous than helpful; it's more important to get people off drugs entirely, even if that means recovery is more difficult40%
 Synthetic drugs are more helpful than dangerous; the approved drugs are safer than heroin or pills bought on the street 24%
